SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 140/7

from Ch. 48, par. 8g

Amends the One Day Rest In Seven Act. Deletes language providing that a violation of the Act is a petty offense. Adds language providing that an employer who violates any of the provisions of the Act is subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for each affected employee for each day that the violation continues.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The One Day Rest In Seven Act is amended by
- 6 (820 ILCS 140/7) (from Ch. 48, par. 8g)

changing Section 7 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 7. Any employer who violates any of the provisions of
- 8 this Act, shall be quilty of a petty offense, and shall be
- 9 subject to a civil penalty fined for each offense in a sum of
- not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for each affected employee
- 11 for each day that the violation continues.
