Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Fire Sprinkler Dormitory Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:

Sec. 10. Fire sprinkler systems required. Subject to the establishment of a fire sprinkler dormitory revolving loan program under Section 15 of this Act, fire sprinkler systems in the dormitories of all post-secondary required educational institutions by 2013, unless a post-secondary educational institution files a compliance plan with the Office of the State Fire Marshal, approved by the Office, by January 1, 2013. The compliance plan shall include a detailed timeline that outlines completion of the planned sprinkler system installations. The Office of the State Fire Marshal may, at its discretion, require periodic updates from a post-secondary educational institution to document its efforts to comply with this Act. All sprinkler installations required by this Act shall be completed and operational by December 31, 2014. A violation of this Section is a business offense punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 per day. This requirement includes current structures as well as newly constructed dormitories.

- Nothing in this Act may be construed to abrogate any statute, 1
- rule, or ordinance requiring that a fire extinguisher be 2
- present in a dormitory. 3
