Amends the Illinois Marriage and Dissolution of Marriage Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the application of the Civil Practice Law.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Marriage and Dissolution of Marriage Act is amended by changing Section 105 as follows:
- 6 (750 ILCS 5/105) (from Ch. 40, par. 105)
- 7 Sec. 105. Application of Civil Practice Law.) (a) <u>The</u>
- 8 provisions of the Civil Practice Law shall apply to all
- 9 proceedings under this Act, except as otherwise provided in
- 10 this Act.
- 11 (b) A proceeding for dissolution of marriage, legal
- 12 separation or declaration of invalidity of marriage shall be
- 13 entitled "In re the Marriage of ... and ...". A custody or
- 14 support proceeding shall be entitled "In re the (Custody)
- 15 (Support) of ...".
- 16 (c) The initial pleading in all proceedings under this Act
- shall be denominated a petition. A responsive pleading shall be
- denominated a response. All other pleadings under this Act
- shall be denominated as provided in the Civil Practice Law.
