AN ACT concerning State government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Act on the Aging is amended by 5 changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 105/4) (from Ch. 23, par. 6104)

7 Sec. 4.

There is created the the Department on Aging. The Director 8 9 of the Department on Aging, in conjunction with the Director of the Department of Public Aid shall prepare and implement a plan 10 personnel, materials, books, 11 to transfer all records, 12 appropriations and equipment related to "Services to Older People" in the Department of Public Aid as described in Article 13 14 VIII of, "The Illinois Public Aid Code", to the Department on Aging by the effective date of this Act. The Department on 15 16 Aging shall administer programs related to "Services to Older 17 People", described in Article VIII of, "The Illinois Public Aid Code", on the effective date of this Act. 18

19 Upon the effective date of this Act, the Department on 20 Aging shall be the single State agency for receiving and 21 disbursing federal funds made available under the "Older 22 Americans Act".
