SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 310/10b.18

from Ch. 124, par. 110b.18

Amends the Secretary of State Merit Employment Code. Grants veteran employees 4 (rather than 2) days per year to visit a veterans hospital for examination of a military service connected disability. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Secretary of State Merit Employment Code is amended by changing Section 10b.18 as follows:
- 6 (15 ILCS 310/10b.18) (from Ch. 124, par. 110b.18)
- 7 Sec. 10b.18. Veterans hospital visits. An employee who is
- 8 also a veteran shall be permitted 4 $\frac{2}{2}$ days per year to visit a
- 9 veterans hospital for examination of a military service
- 10 connected disability. The $\frac{4}{2}$ days shall not be charged against
- any sick leave currently available to the employee.

- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 14 becoming law.
