SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 200/20-5

Amends the Property Tax Code. Provides that, as an alternative to mailing a copy of the bill, the collector may send tax bills via e-mail at the request of the taxpayer.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Property Tax Code is amended by changing Section 20-5 as follows:

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(35 ILCS 200/20-5)

- 7 Sec. 20-5. Mailing tax bill to owner. Every township 8 collector, and every county collector in cases where there is 9 no township collector, upon receiving the tax book or books, shall prepare tax bills showing each installment of property 10 taxes assessed, which shall be filled out in accordance with 11 Section 20-40. A copy of the bill shall be mailed by the 12 collector, at least 30 days prior to the date upon which unpaid 13 14 taxes become delinquent, to the owner of the property taxed or to the person in whose name the property is taxed. As an 15 16 alternative to mailing a copy of the bill, the collector may 17 send the tax bill via e-mail at the request of the taxpayer. If the taxpayer makes such a request, then the taxpayer shall 18 19 notify the collector of any change in his or her e-mail address 20 as soon as possible after the address is changed.
