1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Litter Control Act is amended by changing

- 5 Section 8 as follows:
- (415 ILCS 105/8) (from Ch. 38, par. 86-8) 6
- 7 Sec. 8. Persons who violate any of Sections 4 through 7 are
- 8 subject to the penalties set out in this Section.
- 9 (a) Any person convicted of a violation of Section 4, 5, 6
- or 7 is quilty of a Class B misdemeanor. A second conviction 10
- for an offense committed after the first conviction is a Class 11
- 12 A misdemeanor. A third or subsequent violation, committed after
- a second conviction is a Class 4 felony. 13
- 14 (b) In addition to any fine imposed under this Act, the
- court may order that the person convicted of such a violation 15
- 16 remove and properly dispose of the litter, may employ special
- 17 bailiffs to supervise such removal and disposal, and may tax
- the costs of such supervision as costs against the person so 18
- 19 convicted.
- 20 (c) The penalties prescribed in this Section are in
- 21 addition to, and not in lieu of, any penalties, rights,
- 22 remedies, duties or liabilities otherwise imposed or conferred
- by law. 23

- 1 (d) An individual convicted of violating Section 4 or 2 Section 5 of this Act by disposing of litter upon a public 3 highway may, in addition to any other penalty, be required to maintain litter control for 30 days over a designated portion 4 5 of that highway, including, at the discretion of the agency 6 having jurisdiction over the section of highway in question, 7 the site where the offense occurred, as provided in Section 50 of the Illinois Adopt-A-Highway Act. 8
- 9 (e) A mandatory minimum fine of \$50 must be imposed against

 10 any person who is convicted of violating Section 5 of this Act.
