SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/31-4

from Ch. 38, par. 31-4

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Provides that it is not a required element of obstructing justice that the conduct defining the offense actually or materially prevents the apprehension of, or actually or materially obstructs the prosecution or defense of, any person.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing Section 31-4 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/31-4) (from Ch. 38, par. 31-4)
- 7 Sec. 31-4. Obstructing justice.
- 8 (a) A person obstructs justice when, with intent to prevent
 9 the apprehension or obstruct the prosecution or defense of any
 10 person, he knowingly commits any of the following acts:
- 11 <u>(1)</u> (a) Destroys, alters, conceals or disguises 12 physical evidence, plants false evidence, furnishes false 13 information; or
- 14 <u>(2) (b)</u> Induces a witness having knowledge material to
 15 the subject at issue to leave the State or conceal himself;
 16 or
- 17 <u>(3)</u> Possessing knowledge material to the subject at issue, he leaves the State or conceals himself.
- 19 <u>(b) It is not a required element of obstructing justice</u>
 20 <u>that the conduct set forth in subsection (a) actually or</u>
 21 <u>materially prevents the apprehension of, or actually or</u>
 22 materially obstructs the prosecution or defense of, any person.
- (c) $\frac{\text{(d)}}{\text{Sentence}}$.

- (1) Obstructing justice is a Class 4 felony, except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection (c) (d).

 (2) Obstructing justice in furtherance of streetgang related or gang-related activity, as defined in Section 10 of the Illinois Streetgang Terrorism Omnibus Prevention Act, is a Class 3 felony.
