### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 520/2

Amends the Southern Illinois University Management Act. Replaces the Superintendent of Public Instruction as a voting member of the SIU Board of Trustees by making the second student member (currently non-voting) a voting member of the Board. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Southern Illinois University Management Act
is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 520/2) (from Ch. 144, par. 652)

7 Sec. 2. The Board shall consist of 7 members appointed by the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate  $\overline{r}$ 8 9 the Superintendent of Public Instruction, or his chief assistant for liaison with higher education when designated to 10 serve in his place, ex-officio, and 2 one voting student 11 members member designated by the Governor from one campus of 12 13 the University and one nonvoting student member from the campus 14 of the University not represented by the voting student member. The Governor shall designate one of the student members serving 15 16 on the Board to serve as the voting student member. Each 17 student member shall be chosen by the respective campuses of Southern Illinois University at Carbondale and Edwardsville. 18 19 The method of choosing these student members shall be by campus-wide student election, and any student designated by the 20 21 Governor to be a voting student member shall be one of the students chosen by this method. The student members shall serve 22 terms of one year beginning on July 1 of each year, except that 23

the student members initially selected shall serve a term 1 beginning on the date of such selection and expiring on the 2 3 next succeeding June 30. To be eligible for selection as a student member and to be eligible to remain as a voting or 4 5 nonvoting student member of the Board, a student member must be a resident of this State, must have and maintain a grade point 6 7 average that is equivalent to at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale, and must be a full time student enrolled at all times during his or 8 9 her term of office except for that part of the term which 10 follows the completion of the last full regular semester of an 11 academic year and precedes the first full regular semester of 12 the succeeding academic year at the university (sometimes commonly referred to as the summer session or summer school). 13 14 If a voting or nonvoting student member serving on the Board 15 fails to continue to meet or maintain the residency, minimum 16 grade point average, or enrollment requirement established by 17 this Section, his or her membership on the Board shall be deemed to have terminated by operation of law. No more than 4 18 19 of the members appointed by the Governor shall be affiliated 20 with the same political party. Each member appointed by the Governor must be a resident of this State. A failure to meet or 21 22 maintain this residency requirement constitutes a resignation 23 from and creates a vacancy in the Board. Upon the expiration of 24 the terms of members appointed by the Governor, their 25 respective successors shall be appointed for terms of 6 years 26 from the third Monday in January of each odd-numbered year and
