

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 HB5882

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/1-8.6 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that a post-secondary student who is not a United States citizen and who is enrolled in a public university, college, or community college in this State is ineligible for any public aid benefits provided under the Code. Prohibits a public university, college, or community college in this State from counseling or providing information to such a student on how or where to apply for any public aid benefits provided under the Code.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 1-8.6 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/1-8.6 new)
- Sec. 1-8.6. Post-secondary student; non-citizen;

 ineligible. A post-secondary student who is not a United States

 citizen and who is enrolled in a public university, college, or

 community college in this State is ineligible for any benefits

 provided under this Code. No public university, college, or

 community college in this State shall counsel or provide

 information to such a student on how or where to apply for any
