1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 10

10 Secretary of State, including sidewalks, terraces, and
11 grounds and all labor, materials, and other costs incidental
12 to the above work:

14 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000,000 or so much of this
15 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
16 Development Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
17 new construction and alterations, and maintenance of the
18 interiors and exteriors of the following facilities under the
19 jurisdiction of the Secretary of State: Chicago West
20 Facility, 5301 N. Lexington Ave., Chicago, Illinois 60644;
21 Roger McAuliffe Facility, 5401 N. Elston Ave., Chicago,

21 Section 25. The following amounts, or so much of these
22 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated

1 to the Office of the Secretary of State for the following
2 purposes:

3 For annual equalization grants, per capita and
4 area grants to library systems, and per
5 capita grants to public libraries, under
6 Section 8 of the Illinois Library System
7 Act. This amount is in addition to any
8 amount otherwise appropriated to the Office

22 Section 70. The sum of \$250,000, or so much of this

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 2 Revenue Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the
 3 Penny Severns Summer Family Literacy Grants.

4 Section 75. In addition to any other amounts
 5 appropriated for such purposes, the sum of \$1,432,000, or so
 6 much of this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from
 7 the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
 8 State for a grant to the Chicago Public Library.

9 Section 80. The sum of \$325,000, or so much of this
 10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 11 Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for all
 12 expenditures and grants to libraries for the Project Next
 13 Generation Program.

14 Section 85. The following amount, or so much of this
 15 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
 16 the Secretary of State from the Live and Learn Fund for the
 17 purpose of promotion of organ and tissue donations:

18 From Live and Learn Fund1,750,000

19 Section 90. The sum of \$50,000, or so much of this amount
 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
 21 State Special License Plate Fund to the Office of the

1 Secretary of State for grants to benefit Illinois Veterans
2 Home libraries.

3 Section 95. The amount of \$40,000, or so much of this
4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
5 the Secretary of State from the Master Mason Fund to provide
6 grants to the Illinois Masonic Foundation for the Prevention
7 of Drug and Alcohol Abuse Among Children, Inc., a not-for-
8 profit corporation, for the purpose of providing Model
9 Student Assistance Programs in public and private schools in
10 Illinois.

11 Section 100. The amount of \$75,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
13 from the Illinois Pan Hellenic Trust Fund to provide grants
14 for charitable purposes sponsored by African-American
15 fraternities and sororities.

16 Section 105. The amount of \$35,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
18 from the Park District Youth Program Fund to provide grants
19 for the Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School
20 Programming.

21 Section 110. The amount of \$130,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of
2 State from the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to
3 provide grants for the development of tourism, education,
4 preservation and promotion of Route 66.

5 Section 115. The sum of \$200,000, or so much of this
6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Police
7 Memorial Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
8 State for grants to the Police Memorial Committee for
9 maintaining a memorial statue, holding an annual memorial
10 commemoration, and giving scholarships to children of police
11 officers killed in the line of duty.

12 Section 120. The sum of \$140,000, or so much of this
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
14 Mammogram Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
15 grants to the Susan G. Komen Foundation for breast cancer
16 research, education, screening, and treatment.

17 Section 125. The following amounts, or so much of these
18 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
19 to the Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in
20 Section 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5), for
21 grants to the Regional Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-
22 America Transplant Services for the purpose of promotion of

1 organ and tissue donation awareness. These amounts are in
2 addition to any amounts otherwise appropriated to the Office
3 of the Secretary of State:

4 From Organ Donor Awareness Fund225,000

5 Section 130. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
7 from the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation Fund for grants
8 to the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation for maintenance of
9 a memorial and park, holding an annual memorial
10 commemoration, giving scholarships to children of police
11 officers killed or catastrophically injured in the line of
12 duty, providing financial assistance to police officers and
13 their families when a police officer is killed or injured in
14 the line of duty, and paying the insurance premiums for
15 police officers who are terminally ill.

16 Section 135. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of
18 State from the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide
19 grants for scholarships for Higher Education.

20 Section 140. The amount of \$700,000, or so much of this
21 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS
22 Federal Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State

1 for the payment of any operational expenses relating to the
2 cost incident to augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor
3 Vehicle safety program by assuring and verifying the identity
4 of drivers prior to licensure, including CDL operators; for
5 improved security for Drivers Licenses and Personal
6 Identification Cards; and any other related program deemed
7 appropriate by the Office of the Secretary of State.

8 Section 145. The amount of \$1,291,100, or so much of this
9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
10 the Secretary of State from the Securities Investors
11 Education Fund for any expenses used to promote public
12 awareness of the dangers of securities fraud.

13 Section 150. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
15 the Secretary of State from the Secretary of State Evidence
16 Fund for the purchase of evidence, for the employment of
17 persons to obtain evidence, and for the payment for any goods
18 or services related to obtaining evidence.

19 Section 155. The amount of \$225,000, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels
21 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of
22 administering the Alternate Fuels Act.

1 Section 160. The amount of \$17,124,000, or so much of
2 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
3 Secretary of State Special Services Fund to the Office of the
4 Secretary of State for office automation and technology.

5 Section 165. The amount of \$15,561,600, or so much of
6 this amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
7 Motor Vehicle License Plate Fund to the Office of the
8 Secretary of State for the cost incident to providing new or
9 replacement plates for motor vehicles.

10 Section 170. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much of this
11 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
12 Secretary of State DUI Administration Fund to the Office of
13 Secretary of State for operation of the Department of
14 Administrative Hearings of the Office of Secretary of State
15 and for no other purpose.

16 Section 175. The amount of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
18 Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the payments of
19 goods and services that will assist in the prevention of
20 alcohol-related criminal violence throughout the State.

1 Section 180. The amount of \$500,000, or so much of this
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
3 Secretary of State Police Services Fund to the Secretary of
4 State for purposes as indicated by the grantor or contractor
5 or, in the case of money bequeathed or granted for no
6 specific purpose, for any purpose as deemed appropriate by
7 the Director of Police, Secretary of State in administering
8 the responsibilities of the Secretary of State Department of
9 Police.

10 Section 185. The amount of \$500,000, or so much of this
11 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Office
12 of the Secretary of State Grant Fund to the Office of the
13 Secretary of State to be expended in accordance with the
14 terms and conditions upon which such funds were received.

15 Section 190. The amount of \$24,300, or so much of this
16 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
17 the Secretary of State from the State Library Fund to
18 increase the collection of books, records, and holdings; to
19 hold public forums; to purchase equipment and resource
20 materials for the State Library; and for the upkeep, repair,
21 and maintenance of the State Library building and grounds.

22 Section 195. The following amount, or so much of this

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
 2 the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations,
 3 rehabilitations, new construction, and maintenance of the
 4 interior and exterior of the various buildings and facilities
 5 under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State to enhance
 6 security measures in the Capitol Complex:

7 From General Revenue Fund3,200,000

8 Section 200. The amount of \$8,800,000, or so much of
 9 that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 10 Secretary of State Identification Security and Theft
 11 Prevention Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for all
 12 costs related to implementing identification security and
 13 theft prevention measures.

14 Section 205. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much of this
 15 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
 16 Monitoring Device Driving Permit Administration Fee Fund to
 17 the Office of the Secretary of State for all Secretary of
 18 State costs associated with administering Monitoring Device
 19 Driving Permits per Public Act 95-0400.

20 Section 210. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of this
 21 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent
 22 BAIID Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to

1 reimburse ignition interlock device providers per Public Act
2 95-0400.

3 Section 215. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
5 from the Illinois Professional Golfers Association Junior
6 Golf Fund for grants to the Illinois Professional Golfers
7 Association Foundation to help Association members expose
8 Illinois youngsters to the game of golf.

9 Section 220. The amount of \$70,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
11 from the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to
12 support Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public
13 and private schools within Illinois.

14 Section 225. The amount of \$20,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
16 from the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the
17 Illinois divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl
18 Scouts of the U.S.A.

19 Section 230. The amount of \$15,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
21 from the Support Our Troops Fund for grants to Illinois

1 Support Our Troops, Inc. for charitable assistance to the
2 troops and their families in accordance with its Articles of
3 Incorporation.

4 Section 235. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
6 from the Illinois EMS Memorial Scholarship and Training Fund
7 for grants to the EMS Memorial Scholarship and Training
8 Council for providing scholarships for graduate study,
9 undergraduate study, or both, to children and spouses of
10 emergency medical services (EMS) personnel killed in the
11 course of their employment and for grants for the training of
12 EMS personnel.

13 Section 240. The amount of \$5,000, or so much of this
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
15 the Secretary of State from the Rotary Club Fund for grants
16 for charitable purposes sponsored by the Rotary Club.

17 Section 245. The amount of \$10,000, or so much of this
18 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
19 the Secretary of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund
20 for grants to the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for
21 ovarian cancer research, education, screening, and treatment.

1 Section 250. The amount of \$3,000, or so much of this
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
3 the Secretary of State from the Sheet Metal Workers
4 International Association of Illinois Fund for grants for
5 charitable purposes sponsored by Illinois chapters of the
6 Sheet Metal Workers International Association.

7 Section 255. The amount of \$40,000, or so much of this
8 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
9 the Secretary of State from the Illinois Police Association
10 Fund for providing death benefits for the families of police
11 officers killed in the line of duty, and for providing
12 scholarships, for graduate study, undergraduate study, or
13 both, to children and spouses of police officers killed in
14 the line of duty.

15 Section 260. The amount of \$3,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
17 from the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Fund for
18 grants to the Teamsters Joint Council 25 Charitable Trust for
19 religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational
20 purposes.

21 Section 265. The amount of \$5,000, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State

1 from the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund for grants to
2 the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Foundation of Illinois
3 for operational and program expenses of the Chanute Air
4 Museum.

5 Section 270. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
7 from the Autism Awareness Fund for grants to the Illinois
8 Department of Human Services for the purpose of grants for
9 research, education, and awareness regarding autism and
10 autism spectrum disorders.

11 Section 275. The amount of \$20,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State
13 from the Share the Road Fund for grants to the League of
14 Illinois Bicyclists, a not for profit corporation, for
15 educational programs instructing bicyclists and motorists how
16 to legally and more safely share the roadways.

17 Section 280. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary is appropriated from the Professional Sports
19 Teams Education Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for
20 transfers to the Common School Fund.

21 Section 285. The amount of \$200,000, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of
2 State from the Family Responsibility Fund for all costs
3 associated with enforcement of the Family Financial
4 Responsibility Law.

5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
6 2012.
