1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, On the evening of May 1, 2011, members of the elite United States Navy SEALS, under direct orders from President Barack Obama, conducted a daring raid of a guarded compound in the city of Abbottabad, Pakistan, where it was believed that a high value target in the U.S. War on Terror was hiding; and

  - WHEREAS, Under bin Laden's leadership, al-Qaeda conducted several other bombings and similar attacks in the United States and other nations, resulting in the deaths of countless

- WHEREAS, More than any other terrorist organization,
  al-Qaeda and Osama bin Laden have been the central target in
  the War on Terror, a general term used to describe the efforts
  of the U.S. military and its allies to bring to justice those
  responsible for murdering civilians in the name of religious
  extremism; and
- WHEREAS, The effort to bring the terrorist bin Laden to justice was the direct result of the efforts of President
  Barack Obama and his predecessor, President George W. Bush, who both focused the nation's intelligence resources on finding leaders of al-Qaeda, extracting valuable information, and using that information to ultimately find and kill Osama bin Laden; and
  - WHEREAS, President Obama made a risky and daring decision to send in special forces, rather than bomb the facility in question, to ensure that American citizens would know for sure that the terrorist bin Laden had been eliminated and justice had been done; and
