HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The 14th Amendment of the United States 3 Constitution clearly states that all persons born in the United 4 States are citizens of the U.S. and the state in which they 5 reside; and

6 WHEREAS, For over 100 years, the United States Supreme 7 Court has upheld that citizenship be granted to all individuals 8 born on U.S. soil, regardless of their parent's citizenship 9 status; and

10 WHEREAS, A repeal of the 14th Amendment would have dire and 11 costly effects on the State of Illinois, due to the creation of 12 a lengthy bureaucratic process to confer U.S. citizenship; and

WHEREAS, Denying citizenship to certain U.S.-born children would create a permanent group of non-citizens and the potential for a stateless segment of the population; and

16 WHEREAS, Legislators have initiated a campaign to amend the 17 United States Constitution in a way that undermines a pillar of 18 U.S. civil rights; and
