## HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Car accidents are the leading cause of death of 16 3 to 19-year olds; crashes on the road kill more teens than 4 cancer, homicide, and suicide combined; and

5 WHEREAS, In the United States, teen driver and peer 6 passenger deaths account for one quarter of total teen deaths 7 every year; and

8 WHEREAS, Distracted or impaired teen drivers are not only a 9 danger to themselves, but more than half a million people are 10 involved in crashes every year where a teen driver was behind 11 the wheel; and

12 WHEREAS, According to a study completed in 2011 by the 13 Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and State Farm Insurance, 14 nearly one in five teen drivers involved in fatal crashes were 15 reported to have been distracted while driving; these figures 16 do not account for those accidents that are not reported; and

WHEREAS, Focusing attention on removing distractions and preventing behaviors that are known to raise crash risk, such as speeding, alcohol use, failure to wear a seat belt, distractions from peer passengers, and texting while driving, can lead to successfully and significantly lowering crash risks HR0378 -2- LRB097 12056 GRL 55832 r for teen drivers; and
