- 2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of
- 3 Representatives is pleased to congratulate Sister M. Wencesla
- 4 Rieger, F.S.G.M., of St. Francis of the Martyr St. George, on
- 5 her Diamond Jubilee; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In honor of Sister Wencesla, St. Francis Convent
- 7 in Alton will hold a Jubilee Mass on May 12, 2012; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Sister Wencesla was born March 29, 1925, in
- 9 Weigelsdorf, Kreis Reichenbach, Germany; in 1952, during her
- 10 novitiate training, she was helping at St. Mary's in Papenburg,
- 11 Germany; on March 19, 1953, Sister Wencesla professed her first
- 12 vows at the Motherhouse in Thuine, Germany; after her first
- 13 profession, she was assigned to help the convent in Schwazdorf,
- 14 Germany; and
- WHEREAS, She also worked at St. Joseph's nursing home in
- 16 Thuine, Germany; on March 30, 1954, she came to United States
- 17 and worked in the dietary department of Saint Anthony's
- 18 Hospital in Alton until July 1, 1991; on July 21, 1991, she was
- 19 transferred and worked in the St. Francis Convent dining room;

- 21 WHEREAS, On August 12, 1993, Sister Wencesla transferred to

- 1 St. Sixtus Convent in Hastings, Nebraska, where she cooked and
- 2 did housekeeping for 4 sisters teaching at a nearby grade
- 3 school; the children there called her the "cookie sister";
- 4 Sister Wencesla worked there until 2006; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Since 2006, Sister Wencesla has been in the
- 6 infirmary at St. Francis Convent of Alton and is the oldest
- 7 sister in their American Province; as an Adoration Sister,
- 8 Sister Wencesla spends up to 3 hours in the Adoration Chapel
- 9 praying for sisters, the church, and the world; therefore, be
- 10 it
