7 and was Class Valedictorian on November 2, 1984; he became an
8 EMT-A in 1985; an Advanced Firefighter III in 1986; an EMT-I in
9 1987; an EMT-P in 1988; and a First Class Firefighter in 1988;

11 WHEREAS, He was a Union Board member for 9 years, serving
12 as the Chaplain, Treasurer, Vice-President, and President; and

13 WHEREAS, He was promoted to Lieutenant in 1992; he became
14 the Department Training Officer in 1993 and continued on and
15 off in that role until 2000; he was certified Fire Officer II
16 in 1996; he was promoted to the Rank of Captain in 2000; he
17 directed the Fire Prevention Bureau from 1999 to 2005; and he
18 was certified Fire Inspector I in 2001; and

19 WHEREAS, He was made a Life Safety Code Specialist in 2003;
20 he was promoted to Assistant Fire Chief on December 1, 2004; he
21 received the Illinois Fire Safety Alliance Command and General

1 Staff Certification in 2008; and he was certified as a Fire
2 Officer III in 2010; and

3 WHEREAS, He received the Department's first "Legion of
4 Valor Award"; he implemented the use of FireHouse Management
5 software Department-wide and managed the Department's network
6 and technologies; he became an Arson Investigator in 1997,
7 finishing number one in the class and voted outstanding student
8 by his peers; and

9 WHEREAS, He organized "Harmony Ranch" training events in
10 1996 assisting the "American Heat" video production company,
11 training firefighters world-wide; he authored numerous grants
12 and secured \$1,351,383 for various programs and projects within
13 the Kankakee Fire Department; and he built and maintains the
14 Department Internet website; and

15 WHEREAS, He is married to Beth; their children are Melissa,
16 Melinda, Mackenzi, Mason, and Madison; they also enjoy their
17 grandchildren, Avery, Evan, and Elliot; he plans on cleaning in
18 retirement; therefore, be it
