The Truth in Health Care Professional Services 4 5 Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows: 6 (225 ILCS 145/10) 7 Sec. 10. Definitions. For purposes of this Act: 8 "Advertisement" denotes any communication or statement, whether printed, electronic, or oral, that names the health 9 10 care professional in relation to his or her practice, profession, or institution in which the individual is employed, 11 12 volunteers, or otherwise provides health care services. This 13 includes business cards, letterhead, patient brochures, 14 e-mail, Internet, audio, and video, and any other communication

"Deceptive" or "misleading" includes, but is not limited

or statement used in the course of business.

- 1 any advertisement or affirmative communication or
- 2 representation for health care services that misstates,
- 3 falsely describes, or falsely represents the health care
- 4 professional's skills, training, expertise, education, board
- 5 certification, or licensure.
- 6 "Health care professional" means any person who treats
- human ailments and is subject to licensure or regulation by the 7
- State, including students and residents. "Health care 8
- 9 professional" does not include an individual licensed as a
- 10 dentist under the Illinois Dental Practice Act.
- 11 "Licensee" means a health care professional who holds an
- active license with the licensing board governing his or her 12
- 13 practice in this State.
