1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1576

- 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 1576 by replacing
- 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:
- 4 "Section 5. "An ACT concerning appropriations", Public
- 5 Act 96-956, approved July 1, 2010, is amended by changing
- 6 Sections 15, 25, 30, 35 and 40 of Article 70 as follows:
- 7 (P.A. 96-956, Art. 70, Sec. 15)
- 8 Sec. 15. The amount of  $$20,073,837 \frac{20,603,400}{}$  or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to
- 10 meet the ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate
- 11 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and
- 12 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general
- 13 staff and office operations. Of this amount,  $25.07\% \frac{25.7\%}{25.7\%}$  is
- 14 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such

- 1 expenditures, 25.07% 25.7% is appropriated to the Senate
- 2 Minority Leader for such expenditures and 25.43% 24.8% is
- 3 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
- 4 expenditures, and 24.43%  $\frac{23.8}{\%}$  is appropriated to the House
- 5 Minority Leader for such expenditures.
- 6 (P.A. 96-956, Art. 70, Sec. 25)
- 7 Sec. 25. The amount of \$298,490  $\frac{309,200}{}$ , or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to
- 9 the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
- 10 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses,
- 11 also including the purchasing on contract as required by law
- of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office
- supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended
- 14 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such
- 15 supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred
- 16 without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of
- 17 Representatives. Of this amount, 68.175% 69.277% is
- 18 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
- 19 expenditures and 31.825% 30.723% is appropriated to the
- 20 Speaker of the House for such expenditures.
- 21 (P.A. 96-956, Art. 70, Sec. 30)
- Sec. 30. The amount of \$4,378,008 4,483,050, or so much
- thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to

- 1 the President of the Senate for the use of standing
- 2 committees for expert witnesses, technical services,
- 3 consulting assistance and other research assistance
- 4 associated with special studies and long range research
- 5 projects which may be requested by the standing committees
- 6 and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for Standing
- 7 House Committees pursuant to the Legislative Commission
- 8 Reorganization Act of 1984. Of this amount, 45.587% 46.862%
- 9 is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
- 10 expenditures and 54.413% 53.138% is appropriated to the
- 11 Speaker of the House for such expenditures.
- 12 (P.A. 96-956, Art. 70, Sec. 35)
- 13 Sec. 35. The amount of \$158,650  $\frac{167,000}{1}$ , or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to
- 15 the President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader
- 16 for allowances for the particular and additional services
- appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the
- 18 Senate. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President
- of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated
- 20 to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures.
- 21 (P.A. 96-956, Art. 70, Sec. 40)
- 22 Sec. 40. The amount of \$85,215 88,100, or so much
- thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to

- 1 the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
- 2 Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield
- 3 of members on official legislative business during weeks when
- 4 the General Assembly is not in session. Of this amount,
- 5 64.3% 65.5% is appropriated to the President of the Senate
- for such expenditures and 35.7%  $\frac{34.5\%}{}$  is appropriated to the
- 7 Speaker of the House for such expenditures.
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 9 becoming law.".
