

97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 SB1948

Introduced 2/10/2011, by Sen. William Delgado

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 106/65 new 215 ILCS 170/54 new 305 ILCS 5/5-5.06 new

Amends the Children's Health Insurance Program Act, the Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act, and the Medical Assistance Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that beginning on July 1, 2011, the Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall develop incentive programs for dentists who perform dental services on children covered under the Children's Health Insurance Program, the Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Program, and the Medicaid program. Requires the incentive programs to include a pilot program in a rural and urban designated shortage area that increases rates up to 64% of the reimbursement level that the dentists charge for those services covered. Provides that the Department shall increase the rate level of dental specialty services that are provided to eligible children to equal 64% of the dentist's usual and customary charges. Requires the Department to develop and implement an incentive program that rewards dentists who are enrolled as a "dental home". Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Children's Health Insurance Program Act is amended by adding Section 65 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 106/65 new)

Beginning on July 1, 2011, the Department shall develop incentive programs for dentists 8 9 who perform dental services on children covered under this Act. 10 The incentive programs shall include a pilot program in a rural and urban designated shortage area that increases rates up to 11 12 64% of the reimbursement level that the dentists charge for those services covered. The Department shall 16 17 also develop and implement an incentive program that rewards dentists who are enrolled as a "dental home" with a bonus for 18 19 providing services to children enrolled and covered under this 20 Act.
- Section 10. The Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act is amended by adding Section 54 as follows:

Sec. 54. Provider incentives. Beginning on July 1, 2011, 2 3 the Department shall develop incentive programs for dentists 4 who perform dental services on children covered under this Act. 5 The incentive programs shall include a pilot program in a rural and urban designated shortage area that increases rates up to 6 64% of the reimbursement level that the dentists charge for 7 8 those services covered. In addition, the Department shall increase the rate level of dental specialty services that are 9 10 provided to children covered under this Act to equal 64% of the 11 dentist's usual and customary charges. The Department shall 12 also develop and implement an incentive program that rewards dentists who are enrolled as a "dental home" with a bonus for 13 providing services to children enrolled and covered under this 14 15 Act.

- Section 15. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-5.06 as follows:

The Department shall also develop and implement an incentive program that rewards dentists who are enrolled as a 7 "dental home" with a bonus for providing services to children 8 9 enrolled and covered under this Article.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
