

## 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 SB1971

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

770 ILCS 60/6

from Ch. 82, par. 6

Amends the Mechanics Lien Act. Provides that, to obtain a lien under the Act, the work shall be done or the material furnished: within 3 years from the commencement of the work or the commencement of furnishing the material in the case of work done or material furnished as to owner-occupied residential property; and within 5 years from the commencement of the work or the commencement of furnishing the material in the case of work done or material furnished as to any other type of property. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Mechanics Lien Act is amended by changing

  Section 6 as follows:
- 6 (770 ILCS 60/6) (from Ch. 82, par. 6)
- 7 Sec. 6. In no event shall it be necessary to fix or stipulate in any contract a time for the completion or a time 8 9 for payment in order to obtain a lien under this act, provided, 10 that the work is done or material furnished: within three years from the commencement of said work or the commencement of 11 12 furnishing said material in the case of work done or material furnished as to owner-occupied residential property; and 13 14 within 5 years from the commencement of said work or the commencement of furnishing said material in the case of work 15 16 done or material furnished as to any other type of property.
