1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Non-Support Punishment Act is amended by
5 changing Section 5 as follows:

6 (750 ILCS 16/5)

7 Sec. 5. Prosecutions by State's Attorneys. A proceeding for
8 enforcement of this Act may be instituted and ~~and~~ prosecuted by
9 the several State's Attorneys only upon the filing of a
10 verified complaint by the person or persons receiving child or
11 spousal support.
