

## 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 SB2566

Introduced 1/11/2012, by Sen. John M. Sullivan

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/3A-18

Amends the School Code. Provides that the Streamlining Illinois' Regional Offices of Education Commission shall submit its final report on or before April 1, 2012 (instead of August 1, 2012), and abolishes the Commission on April 2, 2012 (instead of August 2, 2012). Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 4
- 3A-18 as follows: 5
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/3A-18)
- (Section scheduled to be repealed on August 2, 2012)
- Sec. 3A-18. Streamlining Illinois' Regional Offices of 8
- Education Commission.

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(a) Recognizing the virtue of the regional offices of 10 education in that locally elected public servants are working 11 closely with local school boards and superintendents and in 12 partnership with the State Board of Education, and in an effort 13 14 to deliver these educational services more efficiently and effectively, there is hereby established the Streamlining 15 16 Illinois' Regional Offices of Education Commission. 17 Commission shall explore and examine all duties of the State Board of Education and all regional offices of education and 18 19 intermediate service centers, as well as the boundaries of the 20 educational service regions as defined in this Article, in 21 order to determine which duties and responsibilities should be 22 provided regionally to more appropriately and efficiently deliver services and whether the boundaries of the education 9

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- 1 service regions can be expanded to streamline the regional
- 2 offices of education. The Commission shall ensure that its
- 3 recommendations include specifics as to the necessary funding
- 4 to carry out identified responsibilities.
- 5 (b) The Commission shall consist of all of the following voting members:
- 7 (1) One person appointed by the Governor, who shall serve as chairperson of the Commission.
  - (2) One member appointed by the President of the Senate.
- 11 (3) One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate.
  - (4) One member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
    - (5) One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives.
      - (6) One member appointed by an association representing regional superintendents of schools.
  - (7) One member appointed by an association representing school boards.
- 21 (8) One member appointed by an association 22 representing school administrators.
- 23 (9) One member appointed by an association 24 representing school business officials.
- 25 (10) One member appointed by each of 2 statewide 26 associations representing teachers.

- 1 (11) One member from an intermediate service center 2 appointed by the State Superintendent of Education.
  - (12) One district superintendent from an urban school district appointed by the State Superintendent of Education.
  - (13) One district superintendent from a rural school district appointed by the State Superintendent of Education.
  - (14) One representative from the State Board of Education appointed by the State Superintendent of Education.
  - Members appointed by the legislative leaders shall be appointed for the duration of the Commission; in the event of a vacancy, the appointment to fill the vacancy shall be made by the legislative leader of the same house and party as the leader who made the original appointment.
  - (c) The Commission may begin to conduct business upon the appointment of a majority of the voting members.
  - (d) The State Board of Education shall be the agency responsible for providing staff and administrative support to the Commission.
    - (e) Members of the Commission shall receive no compensation for their participation, but may be reimbursed by the State Board of Education for expenses in connection with their participation, including travel, if funds are available.
  - (f) The Commission shall submit a final report of its

- 1 findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General
- 2 Assembly on or before <u>April</u> <u>August</u> 1, 2012. The Commission may
- 3 submit other reports as it deems appropriate.
- 4 (g) The Commission is abolished on April August 2, 2012,
- 5 and this Section is repealed on April August 2, 2012.

- 7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 8 becoming law.
