AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
Section 5-1 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/5-1) (from Ch. 38, par. 5-1)

7 Sec. 5-1. Accountability for conduct of another.

A person is responsible for conduct which is an element of an offense if <u>the</u> the conduct is either that of the person himself, or that of another and he is legally accountable for such conduct as provided in Section 5--2, or both.
