

## 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2011 and 2012 SB3509

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-1134 new

Amends the Counties Code. Authorizes the county board or board of county commissioners of a county to prohibit the use of coal tar pavement product on all roadways, driveways, and parking lots within the county. Defines "coal tar" and "coal tar pavement product".

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section 5-1134 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/5-1134 new)
- 7 Sec. 5-1134. Use of coal tar. The county board or board of county commissioners of a county may prohibit the use of coal 8 9 tar pavement products on all roadways, driveways, and parking lots within the county. For the purposes of this Section, "coal 10 tar" means a viscous substance obtained by the combustion of 11 12 coal and containing levels of polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons in excess of 10,000 milligrams per kilogram. "Coal tar" 13 14 includes, but is not limited to, refined coal tar, high temperature coal tar, or coal tar pitch. "Coal tar" does not 15 16 include any substance listed under Sections 3.135 or 3.140 of 17 the Environmental Protection Act. "Coal tar pavement product" means a material that contains coal tar that is intended for 18 19 use as a pavement sealant.
