AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
amended by changing Section 124A-5 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 5/124A-5)

7 Sec. 124A-5. Judgment for costs of prosecution. When a 8 person person is convicted of an offense under a statute, or at 9 common law, the court shall enter judgment that the offender pay the costs of the prosecution. The costs shall include 10 reasonable costs incurred by the Sheriff for serving arrest 11 warrants, for picking up the offender from a county other than 12 the one in which he or she was convicted, and for picking up 13 14 the offender from a location outside the State of Illinois pursuant either to his or her extradition or to his or her 15 16 waiver of extradition.
