## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. VIII, Sec. 2

Proposes to amend the Finance Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that no special fund in the State treasury shall be subject to sweeps, administrative charge-backs, or any other fiscal or budgetary maneuver that would in any way transfer any amounts from a special fund into any other fund of the State. Effective upon being declared adopted.

### 1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

### 2 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

3	RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL
4	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
5	CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the
6	electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general
7	election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of
8	this resolution a proposition to amend Section 2 of Article
9	VIII of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

10 ARTICLE VIII

11 FINANCE

- 12 (ILCON Art. VIII, Sec. 2)
- 13 SECTION 2. STATE FINANCE
- 14 (a) The Governor shall prepare and submit to the General 15 Assembly, at a time prescribed by law, a State budget for the ensuing fiscal year. The budget shall set forth the estimated 16 17 balance of funds available for appropriation at the beginning 18 of the fiscal year, the estimated receipts, and a plan for 19 expenditures and obligations during the fiscal year of every 20 department, authority, public corporation and quasi-public 21 corporation of the State, every State college and university, 22 and every other public agency created by the State, but not of 23 units of local government or school districts. The budget shall

- 1 also set forth the indebtedness and contingent liabilities of
- 2 the State and such other information as may be required by law.
- 3 Proposed expenditures shall not exceed funds estimated to be
- 4 available for the fiscal year as shown in the budget.
- 5 (b) The General Assembly by law shall make appropriations
- 6 expenditures of public funds by the
- Appropriations for a fiscal year shall not exceed funds 7
- estimated by the General Assembly to be available during that 8
- 9 year.
- 10 (c) No special fund in the State treasury shall be subject
- 11 to sweeps, administrative charge-backs, or any other fiscal or
- 12 budgetary maneuver that would in any way transfer any amounts
- 13 from a special fund into any other fund of the State.
