- 10 honored to have one of the new commissioned ships be named USS
- 11 Aurora; therefore, be it
- 12 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL
- 13 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the President
- 14 and the Secretary of the Navy to name one of the new LCS
- 15 cruiser ships under construction as the USS Aurora in honor of
- 16 the City of Aurora and its many contributions to the welfare of
- 17 the nation; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be given
- 19 to the President and the Secretary of the Navy.
