WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to learn of the death of Robert Arthur Dietmeyer of Gurnee, who passed away on April 6, 2012; and

5 WHEREAS, Robert Dietmeyer was born on May 9, 1927, in 6 Burlington, Iowa; he moved to Waukegan as a child and graduated 7 from Waukegan High School in 1944; and

WHEREAS, Robert Dietmeyer was a member of the United States Army; he served in the 703rd Military Police Battalion in Washington D.C., where he attained the rank of sergeant while helping to guard President Harry Truman; and

WHEREAS, After leaving the Army, Robert Dietmeyer enrolled at the University of Iowa, where he graduated in 1950; he then served as Manager of Corporate Benefits at Abbott Labs, where he worked for 35 years until his retirement in 1986; while at Abbott, he worked towards and earned his master's degree from Marquette University; and

WHEREAS, Robert Dietmeyer served as President of the Holy Name Society of the St. Anastasia Parish in Waukegan and volunteered on the Gurnee Village Civil Service Commission from 1988 to 1991; he was involved with numerous charities,

- 2 American Cancer Society; he was also a founding member of the
- 3 St. Paul's Church Parish in Gurnee and served as a little
- 4 league baseball coach for all 5 of his sons with the North Side

- of 46 years, Catherine Efinger Dietmeyer, and his parents,
