#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the State Universities Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Provides that if an employer notifies the State Universities Retirement System that it has employed an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours in a school year, then the System shall certify to the employer the current value of the annual retirement annuity of that annuitant. Provides that if an employer receives such a certification, then the employer shall pay the certified amount to the System within one year after receiving the certification. Amends the University of Illinois Act, Southern Illinois University Management Act, Chicago State University Law, Eastern Illinois University Law, Governors State University Law, Illinois State University Law, Northeastern Illinois University Law, Northern Illinois University Law, Western Illinois University Law, and Public Community College Act to make conforming changes. Effective July 1, 2012.

1 AN ACT concerning public employee benefits.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding  
5 Section 15-139.1 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/15-139.1 new)

7 Sec. 15-139.1. Employed annuitant certification. If an  
8 employer notifies the System that the employer has employed an  
9 annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours in a  
10 school year, then the System shall certify to the employer the  
11 current value of the annual retirement annuity of that  
12 annuitant. If an employer receives such a certification, then  
13 the employer shall pay the certified amount to the System  
14 within one year after receiving the certification.

15 Section 10. The University of Illinois Act is amended by  
16 adding Section 80 as follows:

17 (110 ILCS 305/80 new)

18 Sec. 80. Employment of annuitants of State Universities  
19 Retirement System. The University of Illinois may employ an  
20 annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per school  
21 year. The University of Illinois may employ an annuitant for

1 more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per school year only  
2 if the University of Illinois also pays to the State  
3 Universities Retirement System an amount equal to the annual  
4 retirement annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall be due  
5 within one year after the University of Illinois receives the  
6 certification of the certified amount from the State  
7 Universities Retirement System. The University of Illinois  
8 must determine if an employee is an annuitant and shall notify  
9 the State Universities Retirement System when the university  
10 employs an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid  
11 hours in a school year. For the purposes of this Section,  
12 "annuitant" means any individual that is receiving a retirement  
13 annuity from the State Universities Retirement System.

14 Section 15. The Southern Illinois University Management  
15 Act is amended by adding Section 65 as follows:

16 (110 ILCS 520/65 new)

17 Sec. 65. Employment of annuitants of State Universities  
18 Retirement System. Southern Illinois University may employ an  
19 annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per school  
20 year. Southern Illinois University may employ an annuitant for  
21 more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per school year only  
22 if Southern Illinois University also pays to the State  
23 Universities Retirement System an amount equal to the annual  
24 retirement annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall be due

1 within one year after Southern Illinois University receives the  
2 certification of the certified amount from the State  
3 Universities Retirement System. Southern Illinois University  
4 must determine if an employee is an annuitant and shall notify  
5 the State Universities Retirement System when the university  
6 employs an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid  
7 hours in a school year. For the purposes of this Section,  
8 "annuitant" means any individual that is receiving a retirement  
9 annuity from the State Universities Retirement System.

10 Section 20. The Chicago State University Law is amended by  
11 adding Section 5-175 as follows:

12 (110 ILCS 660/5-175 new)

13 Sec. 5-175. Employment of annuitants of State Universities  
14 Retirement System. Chicago State University may employ an  
15 annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per school  
16 year. Chicago State University may employ an annuitant for more  
17 than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per school year only if  
18 Chicago State University also pays to the State Universities  
19 Retirement System an amount equal to the annual retirement  
20 annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall be due within one  
21 year after Chicago State University receives the certification  
22 of the certified amount from the State Universities Retirement  
23 System. Chicago State University must determine if an employee  
24 is an annuitant and shall notify the State Universities

1 Retirement System when the university employs an annuitant for  
2 more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours in a school year. For  
3 the purposes of this Section, "annuitant" means any individual  
4 that is receiving a retirement annuity from the State  
5 Universities Retirement System.

6 Section 25. The Eastern Illinois University Law is amended  
7 by adding Section 10-175 as follows:

8 (110 ILCS 665/10-175 new)

9 Sec. 10-175. Employment of annuitants of State  
10 Universities Retirement System. Eastern Illinois University  
11 may employ an annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid  
12 hours per school year. Eastern Illinois University may employ  
13 an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per  
14 school year only if Eastern Illinois University also pays to  
15 the State Universities Retirement System an amount equal to the  
16 annual retirement annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall  
17 be due within one year after Eastern Illinois University  
18 receives the certification of the certified amount from the  
19 State Universities Retirement System. Eastern Illinois  
20 University must determine if an employee is an annuitant and  
21 shall notify the State Universities Retirement System when the  
22 university employs an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or  
23 500 paid hours in a school year. For the purposes of this  
24 Section, "annuitant" means any individual that is receiving a

1 retirement annuity from the State Universities Retirement  
2 System.

3 Section 30. The Governors State University Law is amended  
4 by adding Section 15-175 as follows:

5 (110 ILCS 670/15-175 new)

6 Sec. 15-175. Employment of annuitants of State  
7 Universities Retirement System. Governors State University may  
8 employ an annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid hours  
9 per school year. Governors State University may employ an  
10 annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per  
11 school year only if Governors State University also pays to the  
12 State Universities Retirement System an amount equal to the  
13 annual retirement annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall  
14 be due within one year after Governors State University  
15 receives the certification of the certified amount from the  
16 State Universities Retirement System. Governors State  
17 University must determine if an employee is an annuitant and  
18 shall notify the State Universities Retirement System when the  
19 university employs an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or  
20 500 paid hours in a school year. For the purposes of this  
21 Section, "annuitant" means any individual that is receiving a  
22 retirement annuity from the State Universities Retirement  
23 System.

1 Section 35. The Illinois State University Law is amended by  
2 adding Section 20-180 as follows:

3 (110 ILCS 675/20-180 new)

4 Sec. 20-180. Employment of annuitants of State  
5 Universities Retirement System. Illinois State University may  
6 employ an annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid hours  
7 per school year. Illinois State University may employ an  
8 annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per  
9 school year only if Illinois State University also pays to the  
10 State Universities Retirement System an amount equal to the  
11 annual retirement annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall  
12 be due within one year after Illinois State University receives  
13 the certification of the certified amount from the State  
14 Universities Retirement System. Illinois State University must  
15 determine if an employee is an annuitant and shall notify the  
16 State Universities Retirement System when the university  
17 employs an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid  
18 hours in a school year. For the purposes of this Section,  
19 "annuitant" means any individual that is receiving a retirement  
20 annuity from the State Universities Retirement System.

21 Section 40. The Northeastern Illinois University Law is  
22 amended by adding Section 25-175 as follows:

23 (110 ILCS 680/25-175 new)

1       Sec. 25-175. Employment of annuitants of State  
2 Universities Retirement System. Northeastern Illinois  
3 University may employ an annuitant for up to 100 paid days or  
4 500 paid hours per school year. Northeastern Illinois  
5 University may employ an annuitant for more than 100 paid days  
6 or 500 paid hours per school year only if Northeastern Illinois  
7 University also pays to the State Universities Retirement  
8 System an amount equal to the annual retirement annuity of that  
9 annuitant. Such payment shall be due within one year after  
10 Northeastern Illinois University receives the certification of  
11 the certified amount from the State Universities Retirement  
12 System. Northeastern Illinois University must determine if an  
13 employee is an annuitant and shall notify the State  
14 Universities Retirement System when the university employs an  
15 annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours in a  
16 school year. For the purposes of this Section, "annuitant"  
17 means any individual that is receiving a retirement annuity  
18 from the State Universities Retirement System.

19       Section 45. The Northern Illinois University Law is amended  
20 by adding Section 30-185 as follows:

21       (110 ILCS 685/30-185 new)

22       Sec. 30-185. Employment of annuitants of State  
23 Universities Retirement System. Northern Illinois University  
24 may employ an annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid



1 hours per school year. Northern Illinois University may employ  
2 an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per  
3 school year only if Northern Illinois University also pays to  
4 the State Universities Retirement System an amount equal to the  
5 annual retirement annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall  
6 be due within one year after Northern Illinois University  
7 receives the certification of the certified amount from the  
8 State Universities Retirement System. Northern Illinois  
9 University must determine if an employee is an annuitant and  
10 shall notify the State Universities Retirement System when the  
11 university employs an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or  
12 500 paid hours in a school year. For the purposes of this  
13 Section, "annuitant" means any individual that is receiving a  
14 retirement annuity from the State Universities Retirement  
15 System.

16 Section 50. The Western Illinois University Law is amended  
17 by adding Section 35-180 as follows:

18 (110 ILCS 690/35-180 new)

19 Sec. 35-180. Employment of annuitants of State  
20 Universities Retirement System. Western Illinois University  
21 may employ an annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid  
22 hours per school year. Western Illinois University may employ  
23 an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per  
24 school year only if Western Illinois University also pays to

1 the State Universities Retirement System an amount equal to the  
2 annual retirement annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall  
3 be due within one year after Western Illinois University  
4 receives the certification of the certified amount from the  
5 State Universities Retirement System. Western Illinois  
6 University must determine if an employee is an annuitant and  
7 shall notify the State Universities Retirement System when the  
8 university employs an annuitant for more than 100 paid days or  
9 500 paid hours in a school year. For the purposes of this  
10 Section, "annuitant" means any individual that is receiving a  
11 retirement annuity from the State Universities Retirement  
12 System.

13 Section 55. The Public Community College Act is amended by  
14 adding Section 3-29-10 as follows:

15 (110 ILCS 805/3-29-10 new)

16 Sec. 3-29-10. Employment of annuitants of State  
17 Universities Retirement System. A community college may employ  
18 an annuitant for up to 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per  
19 school year. A community college may employ an annuitant for  
20 more than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours per school year only  
21 if that community college also pays to the State Universities  
22 Retirement System an amount equal to the annual retirement  
23 annuity of that annuitant. Such payment shall be due within one  
24 year after the community college receives the certification of

1 the certified amount from the State Universities Retirement  
2 System. Each community college must determine if an employee is  
3 an annuitant and shall notify the State Universities Retirement  
4 System when the community college employs an annuitant for more  
5 than 100 paid days or 500 paid hours in a school year. For the  
6 purposes of this Section, "annuitant" means any individual that  
7 is receiving a retirement annuity from the State Universities  
8 Retirement System.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July  
10 1, 2012.
