- 3 Section 15. The Metropolitan Transit Authority Act is 4 amended by changing Sections 19 and 22 as follows:
- 5 (70 ILCS 3605/19) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 319)
- 6 Sec. 19. Compensation; pension; benefits.
  - (a) The governing and administrative body of the Authority shall be a board consisting of seven members, to be known as Chicago Transit Board. Members of the Board shall be residents of the metropolitan area and persons of recognized business ability. No member of the Board of the Authority shall hold any other office or employment under the Federal, State or any County or any municipal government except an honorary office without compensation or an office in the National Guard. No employee of the Authority shall hold any other office or employment under the Federal, State or any County or any municipal government except an office with compensation not exceeding \$15,000 annually or a position in the National Guard or the United States military reserves. Provided, however, that the Chairman may be a member of the Board of the Regional Transportation Authority. No member of the Board or employee of the Authority shall have any private financial interest, profit or benefit in any contract, work or business of the Authority nor in the sale or lease of any property to or from the

Authority.

(b) The provisions of this subsection (b) apply only for terms of office beginning before the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly. The salary of each member of the initial Board shall be \$15,000.00 per annum, and such salary shall not be increased or diminished during his or her term of office. The salaries of successor members of the Board shall be fixed by the Board and shall not be increased or diminished during their respective terms of office. No Board member shall be allowed any fees, perquisites or emoluments, reward or compensation for his or her services as a member or officer of the Authority aside from his or her salary or pension, but he or she shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred by him or her in the performance of his or her duties.

(c) For terms of office beginning on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, members of the Board shall be compensated \$500 for attendance at each meeting of the Board and for actual expenses incurred in travel to and from those meetings but shall not be otherwise compensated for service as a member of the Board.

For individuals who first become members of the Board on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, no service or contribution shall be credited in any retirement system or pension fund, under the Illinois Pension Code or otherwise, for service on the Board, and no public funds shall be appropriated, expended, or otherwise

- 10 possible after the appointment of the initial members, the

- 14 The initial chairman and successors shall be elected by the

Such pension systems shall be financed or funded by such means and in such manner as may be determined by the Authority to be economically feasible.

(b) Beginning on the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, the Authority shall not grant any new benefit increase. As used in this subsection (b), "new benefit increase" means (i) an increase in the amount of any benefit provided under the authority of an ordinance adopted under this Section that takes effect after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly and (ii) an expansion of the conditions of eligibility for any benefit

Sec. 3B.06. Compensation; pension; benefits. The Chairman of the Commuter Rail Board shall receive an annual salary of \$25,000. For terms beginning on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, Other members of the Commuter Rail Board other than the Chairperson shall receive an annual salary of \$15,000. For terms of office beginning on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, members of the Commuter Rail Board, other than the Chairperson, shall receive no annual salary or other compensation for their service in office, except that each Each member shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the performance of his duties.

For individuals who first become members of the Board on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, no service or contribution shall be credited in any retirement system or pension fund, under the Illinois Pension Code or otherwise, for service on the Board, and no public funds shall be appropriated, expended, or otherwise obligated for such a retirement system or pension fund credit. For terms of office beginning on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, neither the chairman nor any other member of the Board shall be entitled to participate in a program of life or health insurance as a consequence of his or her service on the Board.
