2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 140 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The State Employees Group Insurance Act of 1971  
5 is amended by adding Sections 2.5, 2.6, 2.7, and 2.8 as  
6 follows:

7 (5 ILCS 375/2.5 new)

8 Sec. 2.5. Application to Regional Transportation Authority  
9 Board members. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act  
10 to the contrary, this Act does not apply to any member of the  
11 Regional Transportation Authority Board with respect to  
12 service on that Board during a term of office that begins on or  
13 after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th  
14 General Assembly.

15 (5 ILCS 375/2.6 new)

1       Sec. 2.6. Application to Suburban Bus Board members.  
2       Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act to the  
3       contrary, this Act does not apply to any member of the Suburban  
4       Bus Board with respect to service on that Board during a term  
5       of office that begins on or after the effective date of this  
6       amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly.

7           (5 ILCS 375/2.7 new)

8       Sec. 2.7. Application to Commuter Rail Board members.  
9       Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act to the  
10       contrary, this Act does not apply to any member of the Commuter  
11       Rail Board with respect to service on that Board during a term  
12       of office that begins on or after the effective date of this  
13       amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly.

15       Sec. 2.8. Application to Chicago Transit Authority Board  
16       members. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act to the  
17       contrary, this Act does not apply to any member of the Chicago  
18       Transit Authority Board with respect to service on that Board  
19       during a term of office that begins on or after the effective  
20       date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly.

21       Section 10. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding  
22       Sections 22-105, 22-106, 22-107, and 22-108 as follows:

1 (40 ILCS 5/22-105 new)

2 Sec. 22-105. Application to Regional Transportation  
3 Authority Board members. This Code does not apply to any  
4 individual who first becomes a member of the Regional  
5 Transportation Authority Board on or after the effective date  
6 of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly with  
7 respect to service on that Board.

8 (40 ILCS 5/22-106 new)

9 Sec. 22-106. Application to Suburban Bus Board members.  
10 This Code does not apply to any individual who first becomes a  
11 member of the Suburban Bus Board on or after the effective date  
12 of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly with  
13 respect to service on that Board.

14 (40 ILCS 5/22-107 new)

15 Sec. 22-107. Application to Commuter Rail Board members.  
16 This Code does not apply to any individual who first becomes a  
17 member of the Commuter Rail Board on or after the effective  
18 date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly with  
19 respect to service on that Board.

20 (40 ILCS 5/22-108 new)

21 Sec. 22-108. Application to Chicago Transit Authority  
22 Board members. This Code does not apply to any individual who  
23 first becomes a member of the Chicago Transit Authority Board

1 on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the  
2 98th General Assembly with respect to service on that Board.

3 Section 15. The Metropolitan Transit Authority Act is  
4 amended by changing Sections 19 and 22 as follows:

5 (70 ILCS 3605/19) (from Ch. 111 2/3, par. 319)

6 Sec. 19. Compensation; pension; benefits.

7 (a) The governing and administrative body of the Authority  
8 shall be a board consisting of seven members, to be known as  
9 Chicago Transit Board. Members of the Board shall be residents  
10 of the metropolitan area and persons of recognized business  
11 ability. No member of the Board of the Authority shall hold any  
12 other office or employment under the Federal, State or any  
13 County or any municipal government except an honorary office  
14 without compensation or an office in the National Guard. No  
15 employee of the Authority shall hold any other office or  
16 employment under the Federal, State or any County or any  
17 municipal government except an office with compensation not  
18 exceeding \$15,000 annually or a position in the National Guard  
19 or the United States military reserves. Provided, however, that  
20 the Chairman may be a member of the Board of the Regional  
21 Transportation Authority. No member of the Board or employee of  
22 the Authority shall have any private financial interest, profit  
23 or benefit in any contract, work or business of the Authority  
24 nor in the sale or lease of any property to or from the

1 Authority.

2 (b) The provisions of this subsection (b) apply only for  
3 terms of office beginning before the effective date of this  
4 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly. The salary of each  
5 member of the initial Board shall be \$15,000.00 per annum, and  
6 such salary shall not be increased or diminished during his or  
7 her term of office. The salaries of successor members of the  
8 Board shall be fixed by the Board and shall not be increased or  
9 diminished during their respective terms of office. No Board  
10 member shall be allowed any fees, perquisites or emoluments,  
11 reward or compensation for his or her services as a member or  
12 officer of the Authority aside from his or her salary or  
13 pension, but he or she shall be reimbursed for actual expenses  
14 incurred by him or her in the performance of his or her duties.

15 (c) For terms of office beginning on or after the effective  
16 date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly,  
17 members of the Board shall be compensated \$500 for attendance  
18 at each meeting of the Board and for actual expenses incurred  
19 in travel to and from those meetings but shall not be otherwise  
20 compensated for service as a member of the Board.

21 For individuals who first become members of the Board on or  
22 after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th  
23 General Assembly, no service or contribution shall be credited  
24 in any retirement system or pension fund, under the Illinois  
25 Pension Code or otherwise, for service on the Board, and no  
26 public funds shall be appropriated, expended, or otherwise

1 obligated for such a retirement system or pension fund credit.  
2 For terms of office beginning on or after the effective date of  
3 this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, neither the  
4 chairperson nor any other member of the Board shall be entitled  
5 to participate in a program of life or health insurance as a  
6 consequence of his or her service on the Board.

9 Sec. 22. Chairperson; terms; compensation. As soon as  
10 possible after the appointment of the initial members, the  
11 board shall organize for the transaction of business, select a  
12 chairman and a temporary secretary from its own number, and  
13 adopt by-laws, rules and regulations to govern its proceedings.  
14 The initial chairman and successors shall be elected by the  
15 Board from time to time for the term of his or her office as a  
16 member of the Board or for the term of three years, whichever  
17 is shorter.

18 The Board shall fix the salary of the chairperson ~~chairman~~  
19 ~~in addition to his salary as a member of the Board,~~ which shall  
20 not be increased or diminished during his or her term of office  
21 as chairperson ~~chairman~~. But if the chairperson ~~chairman~~ is  
22 engaged in any other business or employment during his or her  
23 term as chairperson ~~chairman~~, his or her annual salary shall be  
24 not more than \$25,000.

25 For individuals who first become a member of the Board on

2 General Assembly, no service or contribution shall be credited

7 For terms of office beginning on or after the effective date of  
8 this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, neither the  
9 chairperson nor any other member of the Board shall be entitled  
10 to participate in a program of life or health insurance as a  
11 consequence of his or her service on the Board.

14 amended by changing Sections 2.17, 3.04, 3A.06, and 3B.06 as

17 Sec. 2.17. Employee Pensions.

18 (a) The Authority may establish and maintain systems of  
19 pensions and retirement benefits for such officers and  
20 employees of the Authority as may be designated or described by  
21 ordinance of the Authority; may fix the classifications  
22 therein; may take such steps as may be necessary to provide  
23 that persons eligible for admission to such pension systems as  
24 officers and employees of the Authority or of any

1 transportation agency whose operations are financed in whole or  
2 in part by the Authority, shall retain eligibility for  
3 admission to or continued coverage and participation under  
4 Title II of the federal Social Security Act, as amended, and  
5 the related provisions of the Federal Insurance Contributions  
6 Act, as amended, or the federal Railroad Retirement Act, as  
7 amended, and the related provisions of the Railroad Retirement  
8 Tax Act, as amended, as the case may be; and may provide in  
9 connection with such pension systems, a system of benefits  
10 payable to the beneficiaries and dependents of any participant  
11 in such pension systems after the death of such participant  
12 (whether accidental or otherwise, whether occurring in the  
13 actual performance of duty or otherwise, or both) subject to  
14 such exceptions, conditions, restrictions and classifications  
15 as may be provided by ordinance of the Authority. Such pension  
16 systems shall be financed or funded by such means and in such  
17 manner as may be determined by the Authority to be economically  
18 feasible.

19 (b) Beginning on the effective date of this amendatory Act  
20 of the 98th General Assembly, the Authority shall not grant any  
21 new benefit increase. As used in this subsection (b), "new  
22 benefit increase" means (i) an increase in the amount of any  
23 benefit provided under the authority of an ordinance adopted  
24 under this Section that takes effect after the effective date  
25 of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly and (ii) an  
26 expansion of the conditions of eligibility for any benefit



1 provided under the authority of an ordinance adopted under this  
2 Section that takes effect after the effective date of this  
3 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly.

6 Sec. 3.04. Compensation; pension; benefits. For terms of  
7 office beginning prior to the effective date of this amendatory  
8 Act of the 98th General Assembly, each ~~Each~~ Director including  
9 the ~~Chairman~~ Chairperson, except for the Chairman of the  
10 Chicago Transit Authority who shall not be compensated by the  
11 Authority, shall be compensated at the rate of \$25,000 per  
12 year.

13 For terms of office beginning on or after the effective  
14 date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, the  
15 Chairperson shall be compensated at the rate of \$25,000 per  
16 year, and each Director shall be compensated \$500 for  
17 attendance at each meeting of the Board and for actual expenses  
18 incurred in travel to and from those meetings but shall not be  
19 otherwise compensated for service as a Director or Chairperson;  
20 however, for terms of office beginning on or after the  
21 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General  
22 Assembly, the Chairman of the Chicago Transit Authority shall  
23 not be compensated by the Authority.

25 after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th

22 Assembly, and the other members of the Suburban Bus Board shall  
23 receive an annual salary of \$10,000. For terms of office  
24 beginning on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act  
25 of the 98th General Assembly, members of the Suburban Bus

1 Board, other than the Chairperson, shall be compensated \$500  
2 for attendance at each meeting of the Board and for actual  
3 expenses incurred in travel to and from those meetings but  
4 shall not be otherwise compensated for service as a member of  
5 the Board. ~~Each member shall be reimbursed for actual expenses~~  
6 ~~incurred in the performance of his duties, not to exceed \$5000~~  
7 ~~per year.~~

6 of the Commuter Rail Board other than the Chairperson shall  
7 receive an annual salary of \$15,000. For terms of office  
8 beginning on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act  
9 of the 98th General Assembly, members of the Commuter Rail  
10 Board, other than the Chairperson, shall receive no annual  
11 salary or other compensation for their service in office,  
12 except that each ~~Each~~ member shall be reimbursed for actual  
13 expenses incurred in the performance of his duties.
