Sec. 19. Compensation; pension; benefits.

7 (a) The governing and administrative body of the Authority 8 shall be a board consisting of seven members, to be known as 9 Chicago Transit Board. Members of the Board shall be residents of the metropolitan area and persons of recognized business 10 11 ability. No member of the Board of the Authority shall hold any 12 other office or employment under the Federal, State or any 13 County or any municipal government except an honorary office 14 without compensation or an office in the National Guard. No employee of the Authority shall hold any other office or 15 employment under the Federal, State or any County or any 16 municipal government except an office with compensation not 17 18 exceeding \$15,000 annually or a position in the National Guard 19 or the United States military reserves. Provided, however, that 20 the Chairman may be a member of the Board of the Regional 21 Transportation Authority. No member of the Board or employee of 22 the Authority shall have any private financial interest, profit 23 or benefit in any contract, work or business of the Authority 24 nor in the sale or lease of any property to or from the 1 Authority.

2 (b) The provisions of this subsection (b) apply only for terms of office beginning before the effective date of this 3 4 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly. The salary of each 5 member of the initial Board shall be \$15,000.00 per annum, and 6 such salary shall not be increased or diminished during his or her term of office. The salaries of successor members of the 7 Board shall be fixed by the Board and shall not be increased or 8 9 diminished during their respective terms of office. No Board 10 member shall be allowed any fees, perquisites or emoluments, 11 reward or compensation for his or her services as a member or officer of the Authority aside from his or her salary or 12 13 pension, but he or she shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred by him or her in the performance of his or her duties. 14

15 (c) For terms of office beginning on or after the effective 16 date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, each member of the Board shall be compensated \$500 for attendance at 17 each meeting of the Board and each other meeting he or she is 18 statutorily required to attend in his or her capacity as a 19 20 member of the Board, and for actual expenses incurred in travel to and from those meetings, but he or she shall not be 21 22 otherwise compensated for service as a member of the Board.

Sec. 22. Chairperson; terms; compensation. As soon as 11 possible after the appointment of the initial members, the 12 13 board shall organize for the transaction of business, select a 14 chairman and a temporary secretary from its own number, and 15 adopt by-laws, rules and regulations to govern its proceedings. The initial chairman and successors shall be elected by the 16 17 Board from time to time for the term of his or her office as a 18 member of the Board or for the term of three years, whichever 19 is shorter.

The Board shall fix the salary of the <u>chairperson</u> chairman in addition to his salary as a member of the Board, which shall not be increased or diminished during his <u>or her</u> term of office as <u>chairperson</u> chairman. But if the <u>chairperson</u> chairman is engaged in any other business or employment during his <u>or her</u> term as <u>chairperson</u> chairman, his <u>or her</u> annual salary shall be 1 not more than \$25,000.

1 that persons eligible for admission to such pension systems as employees 2 of officers and the Authority or of anv 3 transportation agency whose operations are financed in whole or 4 in part by the Authority, shall retain eligibility for 5 admission to or continued coverage and participation under 6 Title II of the federal Social Security Act, as amended, and the related provisions of the Federal Insurance Contributions 7 8 Act, as amended, or the federal Railroad Retirement Act, as 9 amended, and the related provisions of the Railroad Retirement 10 Tax Act, as amended, as the case may be; and may provide in 11 connection with such pension systems, a system of benefits payable to the beneficiaries and dependents of any participant 12 13 in such pension systems after the death of such participant 14 (whether accidental or otherwise, whether occurring in the 15 actual performance of duty or otherwise, or both) subject to 16 such exceptions, conditions, restrictions and classifications as may be provided by ordinance of the Authority. Such pension 17 18 systems shall be financed or funded by such means and in such 19 manner as may be determined by the Authority to be economically 20 feasible.

(b) Beginning on the effective date of this amendatory Act
of the 98th General Assembly, the Authority shall not grant any
new benefit increase. As used in this subsection (b), "new
benefit increase" means (i) an increase in the amount of any
benefit provided under the authority of an ordinance adopted
under this Section that takes effect after the effective date

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of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly and (ii) an
 expansion of the conditions of eligibility for any benefit
 provided under the authority of an ordinance adopted under this
 Section that takes effect after the effective date of this
 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly.
