2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Medical District Act is amended by
changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (70 ILCS 915/10) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 5020)

7 Sec. 10. Disposition of money. The Commission is authorized 8 to use all money received from the sale or lease of any 9 property, in excess of the amount as may be necessary to satisfy the obligation of any revenue bond issued pursuant to 10 Section 5 and may also use all money received as rentals for 11 the purposes of planning, acquisition, and development of 12 property within the District and operation, maintenance and 13 14 improvement of property of the Commission and for all purposes and powers set forth in this Act. The Commission shall annually 15 16 enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Auditor 17 General, who shall, at least biennially, audit or cause to be audited by a certified public accountant all records and 18 19 accounts of the Commission pertaining to the operation of the District. The Commission Auditor General shall provide the 20 21 Commission and the General Assembly with the audits and shall 22 post a copy on the Commission's his or her website. The Auditor <u>General shall submit a bill to the Commission for costs</u> 23

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1 associated with the review and the audit required under this

2 Section, and the Commission shall reimburse the Auditor General

3 for such costs in a timely manner.
