Amends the Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning prohibitions.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Use of Intoxicating Compounds Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 690/1) (from Ch. 38, par. 81-1)
- 7 Sec. 1. Use prohibited. No person shall ingest, breathe,
- 8 inhale or drink any compound, liquid, or chemical containing
- 9 toluol, hexane, trichloroethylene, acetone, toluene, ethyl
- 10 acetate, methyl ethyl ketone, trichloroethane, isopropanol,
- 11 methyl isobutyl ketone, methyl cellosolve acetate,
- 12 cyclohexanone, the the alkaloids atropine, hyoscyamine, or
- scopolamine, or any other substance for the purpose of inducing
- 14 a condition of intoxication, stupefaction, depression,
- 15 giddiness, paralysis or irrational behavior, or in any manner
- 16 changing, distorting or disturbing the auditory, visual or
- 17 mental processes. For the purposes of this Act, any such
- 18 condition so induced shall be deemed to be an intoxicated
- 19 condition.
