2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by 5 changing Section 10-102 as follows:

6 (735 ILCS 5/10-102) (from Ch. 110, par. 10-102)

Sec. 10-102. Who may file. Every person imprisoned or otherwise restrained of his or her liberty, except as herein otherwise provided, may apply for habeas corpus in <u>the</u> the manner provided in Article X of this Act, to obtain relief from such imprisonment or restraint, if it prove to be unlawful.
