10	(a) As used in this Sect	zion:
11	"Large capacity ammunit	ion feeding device" means:
12	(1) a magazine, b	elt, drum, feed strip, or similar
13	device that has a cap	acity of, or that can be readily
14	restored or converted	to accept, more than 10 rounds of
15	ammunition; or	
16	(2) any combination	on of parts from which a device

1	described in paragraph (1) can be assembled.
2	"Large capacity ammunition feeding device" does not
3	include an attached tubular device designed to accept, and
4	capable of operating only with, .22 caliber rimfire ammunition.
5	"Large capacity ammunition feeding device" does not include a
6	tubular magazine that is contained in a lever-action firearm or
7	any device that has been made permanently inoperable.
8	(b) Except as provided in subsection (c), it is unlawful
9	for any person within this State to knowingly deliver, sell,
10	receive, transfer, purchase, or cause to be delivered, sold,
11	received, transferred, purchased, or possessed a large
12	capacity ammunition feeding device.
13	(b-5) Except as provided in subsection (c), 180 days after
14	the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General
15	Assembly, it is unlawful for any person within this State to
16	knowingly possess a large capacity ammunition feeding device.
17	(c) Exemptions. This Section does not apply to or affect
18	any of the following:
19	(1) Peace officers as defined in Section 2-13 of the
20	Criminal Code of 2012.
21	(2) Acquisition and possession by a local law
22	enforcement agency for the purpose of equipping the
23	agency's peace officers as defined in paragraph (1) of this
24	subsection.
25	(3) Wardens, superintendents, and keepers of prisons,
26	penitentiaries, jails, and other institutions for the

1	detention of persons accused or convicted of an offense.
2	(4) Members of the Armed Services or Reserve Forces of
3	the United States or the Illinois National Guard, for the
4	performance of their official duties.
5	(5) Any company that employs armed security officers in
6	this State at a nuclear energy, storage, weapons, or
7	development site or facility regulated by the federal
8	Nuclear Regulatory Commission and persons employed as an
9	armed security force member at a nuclear energy, storage,
10	weapons, or development site or facility regulated by the
11	federal Nuclear Regulatory Commission who have completed
12	the background screening and training mandated by the rules
13	and regulations of the federal Nuclear Regulatory
14	Commission for the performance of their official duties.
15	(6) Manufacture, transportation, or sale of large
16	capacity ammunition feeding devices to persons authorized
17	under paragraphs (1) through (5) of this subsection (c) to
18	possess those devices.
19	(7) Manufacture, transportation, or sale of large
20	capacity ammunition feeding devices for sale or transfer in
21	another state.
22	(8) Sale or rental of large capacity ammunition feeding
23	devices for blank-firing prohibited weapons to persons
24	authorized or permitted, or both authorized and permitted,
25	to acquire these devices for the purpose of rental for use
26	solely as props for a motion picture, television, or video

1	production or entertainment event.
2	(d) Sentence. A person who possesses a large capacity
3	ammunition feeding device in violation of this Section commits
4	<u>a Class A misdemeanor for a first violation and a Class 4</u>
5	felony for a second or subsequent violation. A person who
6	delivers, sells, receives, transfers, purchases, or causes to
7	be delivered, sold, received, transferred, purchased, or
8	possessed a large capacity ammunition feeding device in
9	violation of this Section commits a Class 4 felony for a first
10	violation and a Class 3 felony for a second or subsequent
11	violation.".
