5 ILCS 490/175 new

Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Designates the month of November as Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) Month. Effective immediately.

- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- **represented in the General Assembly:**
- 4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
- 5 adding Section 175 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/175 new)
- 7 Sec. 175. Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD)
- 8 Month. The month of November in each year is designated as
- 9 Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) Month to be
- 10 <u>observed throughout the State as a month for the people of</u>
- 11 Illinois to support efforts to decrease the prevalence of COPD,
- develop better treatments, and work toward an eventual cure
- through increased research, treatment, and prevention.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 15 becoming law.
