Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Eminent Domain Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 20-5-25 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 30/20-5-25) (was 735 ILCS 5/7-107)
- 7 Sec. 20-5-25. Persons contesting not to be prejudiced.
- 8 Neither the plaintiff nor nor nor any party interested in the
- 9 property, by taking any action authorized by Sections 20-5-5
- 10 through 20-5-20, inclusive, of this Act, or authorized under
- 11 Article 25 of this Act, shall be prejudiced in any way in
- 12 contesting, in later stages of the proceeding, the amount to be
- finally ascertained to be just compensation.
