1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by changing Section 3.1-15-25 as follows:
- 6 (65 ILCS 5/3.1-15-25) (from Ch. 24, par. 3.1-15-25)
- Sec. 3.1-15-25. Conservators of the peace; service of warrants.
- 9 After receiving a certificate attesting to the successful completion of a training course administered by the 10 Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board, the mayor, 11 aldermen, president, trustees, marshal, deputy marshals, and 12 13 policemen in municipalities shall be conservators of the peace. 14 Conservators of the peace Those persons and others authorized by ordinance shall have power (i) to arrest or cause to be 15 arrested, with or without process, all persons who break the 16 peace or are found violating any municipal ordinance or any 17 criminal law of the State, (ii) to commit arrested persons for 18 19 examination, (iii) if necessary, to detain arrested persons in custody over night or Sunday in any safe place or until they 20 21 can be brought before the proper court, and (iv) to exercise
