A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning alternative dispute resolution.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Uniform Arbitration Act is amended by
5 changing Section 3 as follows:

6 (710 ILCS 5/3) (from Ch. 10, par. 103)

7 Sec. 3. Appointment of arbitrators.

8 If the arbitration agreement provides a method of
9 appointment of arbitrators, this ~~this~~ method shall be followed.
10 In the absence thereof, any method of appointment of
11 arbitrators agreed upon by the parties to the contract shall be
12 followed. An arbitrator so appointed has all the powers of one
13 specifically named in the agreement. When an arbitrator
14 appointed fails or is unable to act, his successor shall be
15 appointed in the same manner as the original appointment. If
16 the method of appointment of arbitrators is not specified in
17 the agreement and cannot be agreed upon by the parties, the
18 entire arbitration agreement shall terminate.
