Amends the Unemployment Insurance Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning rules.

1 AN ACT concerning employment.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Unemployment Insurance Act is amended by changing Section 1701 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 405/1701) (from Ch. 48, par. 611)
- 7 Sec. 1701. Rules <u>and</u> regulations.
- General and special rules may be adopted, amended, or 8 9 rescinded by the Director only after public hearing or opportunity to be heard thereon, of which proper notice has 10 been given. General rules shall become effective ten days after 11 filing with the Secretary of State and publication in one or 12 more newspapers of general circulation in this State. Special 13 14 rules shall become effective ten days after notification to or mailing to the last known address of the individuals or 15 16 concerns affected thereby. Regulations may be 17 amended, or rescinded by the Director and shall become effective ten days after filing with the Secretary of State, 18 19 and such filing shall be public notice of such regulation, 20 amendment thereto, or rescission thereof, as the case may be.
