15	be true and shall be found true in	the final decision issued by

2	employer files a motion to vacate the Administrative Law	
3	Judge's final decision and demonstrates good cause for failing

6	opportunity to answer and the matter shall proceed as if an	
7	original answer to the Department's findings had been filed.";
