Amends the Civic Center Code. Provides that the Authority shall make buildings of a civic center organized under this Code available for emergency purposes. Provides that the Authority shall cooperate in all matters with the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, local emergency management agencies, a State-accredited emergency management agency with jurisdiction, local public health departments, the American Red Cross, and federal agencies concerned with emergency preparedness and response. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Civic Center Code is amended by adding
Section 2-160 as follows:

7 Sec. 2-160. Buildings available for emergency purposes. The Authority shall make buildings of a civic center organized 8 9 under this Code available for emergency purposes upon the request of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, a 10 State-accredited emergency management agency 11 with 12 jurisdiction, or the American Red Cross. The Authority shall cooperate in all matters with the Illinois Emergency Management 13 14 Agency, local emergency management agencies, a 15 State-accredited emergency management agency with jurisdiction, local public health departments, the American 16 17 Red Cross, and federal agencies concerned with emergency 18 preparedness and response.
