SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 420/3-108 new

Amends the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act. Prohibits the Speaker of the House of Representatives, President of the Senate, Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, and Minority Leader of the Senate from engaging in outside employment during their terms of office. Defines "outside employment". Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Governmental Ethics Act is amended
by adding Section 3-108 as follows:

(5 ILCS 420/3-108 new) 6 7 Sec. 3-108. No outside employment during term of office. (a) No Speaker of the House of Representatives, President 8 9 of the Senate, Minority Leader of the House of Representatives, or Minority Leader may engage in outside employment during his 10 11 or her term of office. (b) For the purposes of this Section, "outside employment" 12 means any form of compensated or uncompensated employment or 13 14 business relationship involving the provision of personal services by a person subject to subsection (a) of this Section 15 for an entity other than the State. The term "outside 16 17 employment" includes, but is not limited to, the provision of personal services as an officer, director, employee, agent, 18 19 attorney, consultant, contractor, general partner, trustee, teacher, or speaker. The term "outside employment" does not, 20 21 however, include participation in the activities of a nonprofit 22 charitable, religious, professional, social, fraternal, educational, recreational, public service, or civic 23
