SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Office of New Americans in the Office of the Governor. Requires the Office to maintain and continue to develop on behalf of the people of the State of Illinois a New Americans Immigrant Policy that builds upon the strengths of immigrants, their families, and their institutions, and expedites their journey towards self-sufficiency. Requires the Office to identify strategic partnerships with State agencies. Requires each State agency under the jurisdiction of the Governor to develop a New American Plan that incorporates effective training and resources, ensures culturally and linguistically competent and appropriate services, and includes administrative practices that reach out to and reflect the needs of the immigrant populations and populations with limited English proficiency.

AN ACT concerning State government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
Governor's Office of New Americans Act.

Section 5. Governor's Office of New Americans. The Office 6 7 of New Americans is hereby created in the Office of the Governor. The Office of New Americans shall maintain and 8 9 continue to develop on behalf of the people of the State of Illinois a New Americans Immigrant Policy that builds upon the 10 immigrants, their families, and 11 strengths of their 12 institutions, and expedites their journey towards self-sufficiency. The policy developed by the Office shall 13 14 enable State government to more effectively assist immigrants in overcoming barriers to success and shall facilitate host 15 16 communities' ability to capitalize on the assets of their 17 immigrant populations.

18 The Governor's Office of New Americans shall identify 19 strategic partnerships with State agencies under the 20 jurisdiction of the Governor in an effort to implement best 21 practices, policies, and procedures and make recommendations 22 for statewide policy and administrative changes. 1 Section 10. New American Plans. Each State agency under the 2 jurisdiction of the Governor shall develop a New American Plan 3 that incorporates effective training and resources, ensures 4 culturally and linguistically competent and appropriate 5 services, and includes administrative practices that reach out 6 to and reflect the needs of the immigrant populations and 7 populations with limited English proficiency. Each State agency under the jurisdiction of the Governor shall consider 8 the New Americans Immigrant Policy Council's recommendations 9 in creating the agency's plans. Agency plans should be 10 11 submitted to the Governor for approval.
