(5 ILCS 327/10) 11 Sec. 10. Definitions. As used in this Act: 12 "Agency" means any branch, department, board, committee, 13 14 or commission of State government, but does not include units

of local government, school districts, or boards of election

- 2 "Department" means the Department of Central Management
- 3 Services.
- 4 "Organ" means any biological tissue of the human body that
- 5 may be donated by a living donor, including, but not limited
- 6 to, the kidney, liver, lung, pancreas, intestine, bone, and
- 7 skin or any subpart thereof.
- 8 "Participating employee" means a permanent full-time or
- 9 part-time employee who has been employed by an agency for a
- 10 period of 6 months or more and who donates an organ, bone
- 11 marrow, blood, or a blood component platelets.

- 14 Sec. 20. Administration of Act.
- 15 (a) On request, but subject to the operating needs of the
- 16 <u>employing agency</u>, a participating employee subject to this Act
- may be entitled to organ donation leave with pay.
- 18 (b) An employee may use (i) up to 30 days of organ donation
- 19 leave in any 12-month period to serve as a bone marrow donor,
- 20 (ii) up to 30 days of organ donation leave in any 12-month
- 21 period to serve as an organ donor, and (iii) time, as set forth
- 22 by Department rule, to donate any blood component, up to one
- 23 hour or more to donate blood every 56 days, and (iv) up to 2
- 24 hours or more to donate blood platelets in accordance with
- 25 appropriate medical standards established by the American Red

- 1 Cross, America's Blood Centers, the American Association of
- 2 Blood Banks, or other nationally-recognized standards. <u>It is</u>
- 3 recognized that technology may advance at a rate that outpaces
- 4 the General Assembly's ability to address those advances
- 5 legislatively. To the extent that this Act may not expressly
- 6 apply to those technological advances, this Act should
- 7 nonetheless be interpreted to further the declared policy of
- 8 this Act. Leave under item (iv) may not be granted more than 24
- 9 times in a 12-month period.
- 10 (c) An employee may use organ donation leave or other leave
- 11 authorized in subsection (b) of this Section only after
- obtaining approval from the employee's agency.
- 13 (d) An employee may not be required to use accumulated sick
- or vacation leave time before being eligible for organ donor
- 15 leave.
- 16 (e) The Department must adopt rules governing organ
- donation leave, including rules that (i) establish conditions
- and procedures for requesting and approving leave and (ii)
- 19 require medical documentation of the proposed organ or bone
- 20 marrow donation before leave is approved by the employing
- 21 agency.
