SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$71,000,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department on Aging for funding for an additional \$1.70 per hour to be paid to vendors of homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services in the Community Care Program for the purpose of increasing, by at least \$1.00 per hour, the wages paid by those vendors to their employees who provide homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services. Appropriates \$6,100,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for similar funding purposes for the Home Services Program. Effective July 1, 2013.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$71,000,000, or so much of that
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
6 Revenue Fund to the Department on Aging for funding the
7 following:

8 An additional \$1.70 per hour to be paid to vendors of
9 homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services in the Community
10 Care Program for the purpose of increasing, by at least \$1.00
11 per hour, the wages paid by those vendors to their employees
12 who provide homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services.

13 Section 10. The amount of \$6,100,000, or so much of that
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
15 Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for funding
16 the following:

17 An additional \$1.70 per hour to be paid to vendors of
18 homemaker, chore, and housekeeping services in the Home
19 Services Program for the purpose of increasing, by at least
20 \$1.00 per hour, the wages paid by those vendors to their
21 employees who provide homemaker, chore, and housekeeping
22 services.

1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
2 2013.
