## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5-117 as follows:
- 6 (220 ILCS 5/5-117 new)
- 7 Sec. 5-117. Supplier diversity goals.
- 8 (a) The public policy of this State is to collaboratively
  9 work with companies that serve Illinois residents to improve
- their supplier diversity in a non-antagonistic manner.
- 11 (b) The Commission shall require all gas, electric, and
- 12 <u>water companies with at least 100,000 customers under its</u>
- authority to submit an annual report by April 15, 2015 and
- 14 <u>every April 15 thereafter, in a searchable Adobe PDF format, on</u>
- 15 <u>all procurement goals and actual spending for female-owned</u>,
- minority-owned, veteran-owned, and small business enterprises
- in the previous calendar year. These goals shall be expressed
- 18 <u>as a percentage of the total work performed by the entity</u>
- 19 <u>submitting the report</u>, and the actual spending for all
- 20 <u>female-owned</u>, <u>minority-owned</u>, <u>veteran-owned</u>, <u>and small</u>
- 21 <u>business enterprises shall also be expressed as a percentage of</u>
- 22 <u>the total work performed by the entity submitting the report.</u>
- 23 (c) Each participating company in its annual report shall

1	include the following information:
2	(1) an explanation of the plan for the next year to
3	increase participation;
4	(2) an explanation of the plan to increase the goals;
5	(3) the areas of procurement each company shall be
6	actively seeking more participation in in the next year;
7	(4) an outline of the plan to alert and encourage
8	potential vendors in that area to seek business from the
9	<pre>company;</pre>
10	(5) an explanation of the challenges faced in finding
11	quality vendors and offer any suggestions for what the
12	Commission could do to be helpful to identify those
13	vendors;
14	(6) a list of the certifications the company
15	recognizes;
16	(7) the point of contact for any potential vendor who
17	wishes to do business with the company and explain the
18	process for a vendor to enroll with the company as a
19	minority-owned, women-owned, or veteran-owned company; and
20	(8) any particular success stories to encourage other
21	companies to emulate best practices.
22	(d) Each annual report shall include as much State-specific
23	data as possible. If the submitting entity does not submit
24	State-specific data, then the company shall include any
25	national data it does have and explain why it could not submit
26	State-specific data and how it intends to do so in future

- reports, if possible. 1
- 2 Each annual report shall include the rules,
- 3 regulations, and definitions used for the procurement goals in
- 4 the company's annual report.
- 5 (f) The Commission and all participating entities shall
- hold an annual workshop open to the public in 2015 and every 6
- year thereafter on the state of supplier diversity to 7
- collaboratively seek solutions to structural impediments to 8
- 9 achieving stated goals, including testimony from each
- participating entity as well as subject matter experts and 10
- 11 advocates. The Commission shall publish a database on its
- 12 website of the point of contact for each participating entity
- 13 for supplier diversity, along with a list of certifications
- 14 each company recognizes from the information submitted in each
- annual report. The Commission shall publish each annual report 15
- 16 on its website and shall maintain each annual report for at
- 17 least 5 years.
