## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/11-4.2

from Ch. 46, par. 11-4.2

Amends the Election Code. Provides that no building or part of a building shall be designated or used as a polling place if spirituous or intoxicating liquor is sold anywhere on the premises.

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 11-4.2 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/11-4.2) (from Ch. 46, par. 11-4.2)
- 7 Sec. 11-4.2. (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 8 (b) all polling places shall be accessible to handicapped and
- 9 elderly voters, as determined by rule of the State Board of
- 10 Elections.
- 11 (b) Subsection (a) of this Section shall not apply to a
- polling place (1) in the case of an emergency, as determined by
- 13 the State Board of Elections; or (2) if the State Board of
- 14 Elections (A) determines that all potential polling places have
- been surveyed and no such accessible place is available, nor is
- the election authority able to make one accessible; and (B)
- 17 assures that any handicapped or elderly voter assigned to an
- inaccessible polling place, upon advance request of such voter
- 19 (pursuant to procedures established by rule of the State Board
- of Elections) will be provided with an alternative means for
- 21 casting a ballot on the day of the election or will be assigned
- 22 to an accessible polling place.
- (c) No later than December 31 of each even numbered year,

- 1 the State Board of Elections shall report to the Federal
- 2 Election Commission the number of accessible and inaccessible
- 3 polling places in the State on the date of the next preceding
- 4 general election, and the reasons for any instance of
- 5 inaccessibility.
- 6 (d) No building or part of a building shall be designated
- 7 <u>or used as a polling place if spirituous or intoxicating liquor</u>
- 8 <u>is sold anywhere on the premises.</u>
