Amends the Code of Civil Procedure. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the improper disclosure of records relating to medical studies.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,

represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by changing Section 8-2105 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 5/8-2105) (from Ch. 110, par. 8-2105)
- 7 Sec. 8-2105. Improper disclosure. The disclosure of <u>any</u> any
- 8 information, records, reports, statements, notes, memoranda or
- 9 other data obtained in any such medical study except that
- 10 necessary for the purpose of the specific study is unlawful,
- and any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of
- 12 Part 21 of Article VIII of this Act is guilty of a Class A
- misdemeanor.
